## What makes Sands End sustainable?

Sands End Arts & Community Centre is an independent charity based in a beautiful, fully accessible, sustainable building, located on the edge of the picturesque open space of South Park in Fulham: it was completed in 2020 and was RIBA's London Building of the Year 2022 for good reason.

This sustainable venue is thoughtfully designed to harmonise with its natural surroundings, offering large, airy spaces ideal for corporate and private events alike. Positioned at the entrance to South Park, Sands End features a series of interconnected, light-filled spaces, including a large hall, breakout areas, a Lodge gallery repurposed from a historic building, landscaped gardens and a peaceful grove of walnut trees.

Designed by Mæ Architects, this venue serves a vibrant, diverse community that played an active role in its creation, ensuring it met local needs with essential features like a café, changing rooms, and versatile event spaces. Inspired by the glasshouses that once occupied the site, the distinctive monopitch roofs create an intimate atmosphere around a central courtyard, rising to double height along the park boundary. This thoughtful design reduces carbon costs while enhancing energy efficiency.

Sustainable materials are integral to the venue's structure. Large cross-laminated timber (CLT) and glulam frames support the building, complimented by green-stained timber paneling inside. The exterior brickwork, supplied by specialist StoneCycling, upcycles over 28 tonnes of potential construction waste. Custom 'Nougat' WasteBasedBricks®, composed of 60% recycled material and laid on their sides to minimise usage, were created specifically for Sands End, making this the first UK project to feature them.

The building's orientation also reduces energy demands. South-facing windows are shaded by overhangs, while a passive ventilation system, high-level vents combined with low-level windows, keeps the spaces naturally cool and comfortable.

## Making a Difference in the Community

- Educational Partnerships: Collaborations with local schools offer free music workshops, performances, and student art exhibitions, enriching the cultural landscape.
